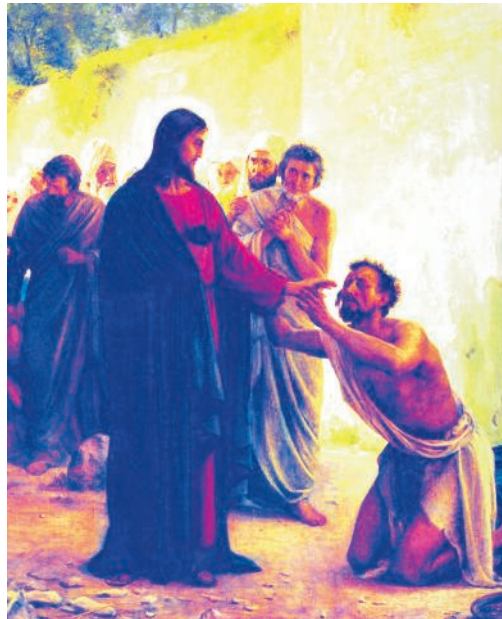

DECREE from Archbishop Gustavo Garcia-Siller, MSPS

Archbishop Gustavo issued a decree on March 13 with info from CDC and state officials regarding COVID-19.

For the good of the Christian faithful he decrees:

1. The Sunday Mass obligation is dispensed for all Catholic effective immediately, except for small groups, such as daily Mass, We must bury the dead, and funerals will still take place with awareness of congregation size.
2. All non-essential gatherings at parishes for the rest of March are cancelled or postponed.
3. We are advising against home visits. We must also follow hospital and nursing home guidelines.
4. I encourage viewing and participating in the daily and Sunday Mass via CTSA or other television outlets.

DECRETO del Arzobispo Gustavo Garcia-Siller, MSPS

Con la información por el CDC, así como por funcionarios de salud locales y estatales con respeto al COVID-19 y para el bien de los fieles cristianos y nuestra comunidad, decreto que:

1. La obligación de la misa dominical se dispensa a todos los católicos con vigencia inmediata, a excepción de grupos pequeños a discreción de cada parroco, como en los casos de misa entre semana. Debemos enterrar a los muertos y los servicios funerarios se seguirán llevando a cabo, teniendo en cuenta el número de los congregantes.
2. Todas las reuniones no esenciales en las parroquias para el resto de marzo se cancelan o posponen.
3. Desaconsejamos visitas a domicilio. Debemos seguir las pautas de los hospitales y hogares de ancianos con respeto al acceso.
4. Exhorto a ver y participar en las misas diarias y dominicales a través de la televisión.

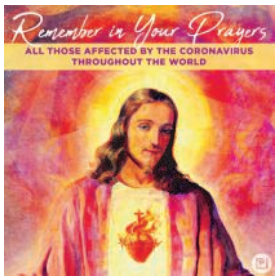

4th Sunday of Lent

“Do you believe in the Son of Man?” Jesus wants to motivate each one of us to see the truth. After developing a relationship

with Jesus, the blind man “sees” as someone very special. The Pharisees, due to the blindness caused by their ignorance, prejudice, and need for self-preservation, still remain blind. Presuppositions, prejudices, assumptions, and our needs can easily blind us to truth. We see what we want or need to see and not what is really there. In addition, our stubbornness continues to convince us that we are right and that our vision is perfect. Only God can complete the picture.

Look around at our world. So much of what is happening today is due to the reluctance of folks to allow themselves to be stretched and brought to see what is really there. Many react to what life presents to them more with the lenses of ignorance than lenses of clarity. The Gospel carries great transformative value. With it, God corrects our vision and replaces our limited sight with the fullness of his sight. God opens our eyes so that we can see that it is not about preserving what we have created but of living in the immensity and wonder of God’s kingdom.

Through a simple, loving relationship with God, we can break through the tethers of prejudice, eradicate fear, dispel the darkness of hatred and sin, discover freedom, live in peace, work for justice, be effective stewards of creation, assist the migrant and the immigrant, and safeguard our economic systems and policies so that they truly serve all of God’s children. What we see is often an artificial lie. Our truth is much bigger than what our limited sight believes it to be. Allow God to work in and through you. Do not be afraid. Be open and be humble enough to know that you need help. Many human beings are living with severe cataracts that produce sight that is at best blurred. Are you one of them?
